पुस्तक के विषय में

समष्टि अर्थशास्त्र का यह दूसरा संस्करण है, जो वर्ष 2000 में विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा सुझाए गए मॉडल पाठ्यक्रम के अनुसार तैयार किया गया है। इस मॉडल पाठ्यक्रम को सभी विश्वविद्यालयों ने लागू कर दिया है और अब समष्टि अर्थशास्त्र स्नातक-पूर्व तथा स्नातकोत्तर, दोनों स्तरों पर एक अनिवार्य पाठ्य विषय है। पुस्तक सात भागों में विभक्त है:– प्रस्तावना, राष्ट्रीय आय एवं आर्थिक लेखांकन, राष्ट्रीय उत्पाद एवं रोजगार, मुद्रा का सिद्धांत, ब्याज का सिद्धांत, कीमतों का सिद्धांत तथा समष्टि आर्थिक नीति। इस संस्करण के अध्याय 20 में, 'भारत में मुद्रा आपूर्ति' और अध्याय 35 में 'भारत में मौद्रिक नीति', दो नए खण्ड जोड़े गए हैं। इनके अतिरिक्त पुस्तक के अन्त में दो परिशिष्टि भी जोड़े गए हैं: (1) "आपूर्ति-पक्ष अर्थशास्त्र" पर टिप्पणी और (2) "नवीन परम्परागत समष्टि अर्थशास्त्र पर टिप्पणी"। हर अध्याय के अन्त में विद्यार्थियों के मार्गदर्शन के लिए कुछ प्रश्न तथा उत्तर संकेत भी दिए गए हैं। प्रस्तुत पुस्तक विभिन्न विश्वविद्यालयों के स्नातक पूर्व एवं स्नातकोत्तर कक्षाओं के विद्यार्थियों के लिए लिखी गई है, परन्तु यह

प्रतियोगी परीक्षाओं में भाग लेने वालों के लिए भी उपयोगी रहेगी।

पुरत्व के सिद्धान्त" शीर्षक से प्रकाशित पुस्तक राजस्व संबंधी सिद्धान्तों एवं भारतीय राजस्व नीति तथा प्रणाली का अत्यन्त सरल भाषा में सिंहावलोकन प्रस्तुत करती है और यह विशेष रूप से भारतीय विश्वविद्यालयों मे पढ़ने वाले विद्यार्थियों की सहायतार्थ लिखी गई है। राष्ट्रभाषा में लिखित यह पहली पुस्तक है जिसमें लोक वित्त के सिद्धान्तों का अध्ययन न्यायपूर्ण एवं सरल भाषा में प्रस्तुत किया गया हैं। इस पुस्तक के दो भाग हैं : राजस्व के सिद्धान्त तथा भारत में सार्वजनिक वित्त । नवीनतम आंकड़ो के अतिरिक्त हिन्दी भाषी क्षेत्रों मे स्थित विश्वविद्यालयों के पाठ्यक्रमों में किए गए परिवर्तनों को पूर्णरूपेण पुस्तक में समाविष्ट किया गया है। पुस्तक के पहले भाग में 28 और दूसरे भाग में 12 अध्याय हैं। इसकी भाषा सरल तथा शैली रुचिकर है। इसमें उन तकनीकी एवं परिभाषिक शब्दों का उपयोग किया गया है जो भारत सरकार द्वारा प्रकाशित परिभाषित शब्द—संग्रह में दिए गए हैं। यह पुस्तक विद्यार्थियों की आवश्यकताओं को ध्यान में रख कर लिखी गई हैं।

पुस्तक के विषय में "आर्थिक विचारों का इतिहास" राष्ट्र–भाषा में कदाचित पहला प्रयास था, जो भारतीय विद्यार्थियों की आवश्यकताओं की पूर्ति के लिए किया गया था। इस का पहला संस्करण 1976 में प्रकाशित हुआ था। उस समय अंग्रेजी भाषा में तो अनेक अच्छी–अच्छी पुस्तकें थीं। किन्तु हिन्दी भाषा मे यह पहली पुस्तक थी जिसमें विश्व के विभिन्न भागों में विकसित आर्थिक विचार धाराओं का क्रमानुसार इतिहास प्रस्तुत किया गया है। साथ ही, यह विभिन्न भारतीय विश्वविद्यालयों के पूर्व–स्नातक एवं उत्तर–स्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों पर आधारित है। इसकी भाषा अत्यन्त सरल है। पुस्तक के दो भाग हैं: प्रथम भाग के 36 अध्यायों में विदेशों में आर्थिक विचारों के विकास का विवरण दिया गया है, और दूसरे भाग के 5 अध्यायों में भारत में आर्थिक विचारों के विकास का विवेचन प्रस्तुत किया गया है। 35 वें अध्याय में 1969 से 2007 तक 61 नोबैल पुरस्कार प्रदत्त अर्थशास्त्रियों के योगदानों का वर्णन पुस्तक की एक अद्वितीय विशेषता है जबकि 36 वां अध्याय अन्य विश्व–प्रसिद्वअर्थशास्त्रियों के विचारों का विवेचन प्रस्तूत करता है।
